

The Senior Women's National Team program is holding player identification camps out East and West. These camps represent the beginning of the training cycle for the Pan Am Championships and the 2011 Pan Am Games. Players of current junior age are strongly encouraged to attend these camps due to their importance and future implications. Please carefully read the following information regarding the women's program.

- Attendance at the upcoming West camp or the East camp is mandatory for any player considering playing for the national team for the 2011 Pan Am Championships and/or the 2011 Pan Am Games. *If a player is not in attendance at either camp they will not be eligible to be team members for these events.* All players in attendance at either camp will be considered a member of the eligible pool of players. In the event there are *medical reasons* preventing attendance at the camp, a letter must be submitted in writing via e-mail, to the CTHF Management Committee (c/o Francois Lebeau) for the purpose of receiving an exemption; *without an exemption the player in question would be considered ineligible.*
- All potential players should be advised that in the event a specialist (i.e. goalie) is deemed medically unfit to play prior to a major competition *and* there are no other specialists available within the pool of eligible players, the coach may petition the Management Committee to allow an ineligible player to participate.
- The East camp is being held in Drummondville on February 5th and 6th. The registration deadline is January 20th and the cost is \$50 per athlete which is due payable to your provincial office by the registration deadline. Players who are registering should also e-mail the Head Coach Mike Nahmiash informing him of the registration. Minimum participation for the camp to occur is 8 athletes. Fees are refundable only if the camp does not occur.
