Canadian Team Handball Federation's Hall of Fame

The Canadian Team Handball Federation has already established the Canadian Team Handball Federation Hall of Fame to honor men and women who have made notable contributions as athletes, coaches, referees or builders to the Team Handball movement in Canada or in the provinces.

We invite the Provincial Team Handball Federations and individuals to submit nomination of candidates to receive such recognition. For 2010, nominations must be submitted to the CTHF office no later than April 30th, 2010.

New members to be inducted in the Canadian Team Handball Federation's Hall of Fame will be elected at the 2010 Canadian Team Handball Federation Annual General Meeting in Edmonton, Alberta, May 21st – 23rd, 2010.

The following guidelines will govern the selection of individuals to the Canadian Team Handball Federation Hall of Fame:

Eligibility

Membership in the Hall of Fame is open to athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, and volunteers builders who have served the cause of team handball with distinction. Nominees must have participated in team handball, or contributed to the growth and development of team handball, at the provincial, national or international levels during their career.

Athlete nominees must have achieved a significant honor in provincial, national or international competition, have been successful over a five-year period, and have retired from competition for a **minimum** of three years.

Coaches, officials, administrators, and volunteers nominees may be either active or inactive at the time of their nomination. Coaches, officials, administrators, and volunteers nominated as builders must have been provincially, nationally or internationally successful over a five year period.

Nominees must have held Canadian citizenship or Canadian residency over the course of their careers.

Nomination

As of 2001, Provincial Team Handball Federations may annually submit two nominations in each category. Deceased athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, and volunteers builders are eligible for consideration. The CTHF Management Committee may annually submit two nominations in each category.

Nominees will be considered for induction in the year nominated, and, if requested by the nominator, for up to two successive years thereafter.

In the event that a nominee is not selected for induction within the three-year period, the nomination will be inactive and may only be resubmitted after a period of three years has elapsed.

A maximum of five pages of supporting documentation may accompany each nomination.

Selection

A selection committee appointed by the Canadian Team Handball Federation Management Committee will evaluate nominees on the basis of the significance and scope of their achievements, their dedication to team handball, the consistency of their performance, and personal qualities such as leadership, sportsmanship, and community service.

Awards

Elected candidates shall receive a CTHF plaque. Their pictures and career history/contribution to team handball history shall be enclosed in the CTHF Web page - Hall of Fame (<http://www.handballcanada.ca>).
