Invitation to next CTHF Annual General Meeting

The Canadian Team Handball Federation will celebrate its 2007 Annual General Meeting in Quebec City, Quebec, May 18th – 20st, 2007. The meeting will take place during the Senior Men and Women Canadian Championships, May 17th – May 20st, 2007. Annual General Meeting and Championship schedules will be set in coordination so delegates can attend both events.

The official hotel of the Senior Nationals is yet to be announced by the host provincial federation. However this hotel should be the site of the coaches and officials meeting, the banquet of the tournament and the site of the CTHF Annual General Meeting.

For economical reasons, provincial delegates wishing to share a room with a delegate from another province are requested to contact the CTHF office before April 13th, 2007. March 25th 2007: Deadline for PTHF to provide list of officials for Nationals

April 1st, 2007: Deadline to bid to host a 2008 National Championship

April 13th, 2007:

The CTHF shall **receive** from the PTHF the following on or prior to **April 20th, 2007:**

- a) **2007-2008** Provincial Affiliation Fee;
- b) **2006-2007** Provincial Memberships lists including all coaches, players, referees and volunteers;
- c) Team Rosters for all Junior teams (with uniform numbers) taking part at the Canadian Championship (**Form #2**);

April 27th, 2007:
