At the AGM, the provincial representatives adopted measures with the purpose of increasing the number of senior teams in both genders. In the near future you will receive the minutes of our last AGM which will provide more details on these measures.

## **Senior Women Pan-Am Championships**

Our national team was in Dominican Republic with high expectations of qualifying for the next World Championships to be held December 2007 in France.

Unfortunately, despite their efforts over the last two years, our team finished in the 6<sup>th</sup> position at the tournament. Along with Argentina, Canada lost by the shortest difference against Brazil and they are also the team that scored the most goals against the Brazilian team (17). The Canadians played an intense first half against the Brazilian team. We hope that the experience they acquired during this tournament will be of assistance in the next Pan-Am games in Rio during the month of July.
