CTHF 2008 National Championships

The CTHF Management Committee announces two major changes in the categories juvenile and junior.

The Juvenile Championships are transferred from the province of Manitoba to the province of Alberta. The Juvenile National Championships will be in Sherwood Park, Alberta at the Millennium Place.

The Junior Championships are still hosted by the province of Quebec, but the venue has changed. It will be transferred from the metropolitan area to the Quebec City area. It will be the Chaudière-Appalaches Handball Club that will be the LOC.
