CTHF 2010 National Championships

The CTHF would like to congratulate all the provincial federations for respecting the February 26th deadline for the team's registration at the next National Championships. There is a considerable increase in team numbers for the senior category and the 21 and under category.

In the 21 and under category, the minimum number of teams will be 6 in the men's category and 5 in the women's category. We are still waiting for some confirmation from two provinces to increase those numbers.

As for the senior men category, a minimum of 8 teams will compete for the gold medal and there a possibility of having 10 teams participating. As for the women, we will have a minimum of 4 teams and a possibility of 6 teams.

The CTHF would like to underline the participation of a team from Nova Scotia in the senior men category. Mr Thorsten Sattler took the responsibility of gathering a sufficient number of players that permits this province a first participation since 1990.

We are also pleased to host the US Condor Handball Club team in the senior men category. This team is under the supervision of Mr Mike Hurdle and Mr Darrick Heath.

This team is a four time indoor national champion and three time beach national champion. Their presents will be a great asset for our championship.

- a) Entry fees for all teams taking part in the Senior and 21 and under Canadian Championship (**\$700** per team);
- b) Good conduct/Performance Bond (**\$200** per team);
